

**Creasey Bicentennial
Grand Blanc Dog Park
Frequently Asked Questions**

Q. What is a dog park? A. *A dog park is a location set aside for dogs and their owners to exercise and play off-leash in a controlled (i.e., fenced) environment.*

Q. What are the hours of the dog park in Grand Blanc? A. *Park hours are 8:00 a.m. to dusk (subject to closure for required maintenance operations). Under no circumstances are you permitted in the park before 8:00 a.m. or after 10:00 p.m.*

Q. If I observe a problem at the park, what should I do?

- *For maintenance, disruptive animals, etc., or for customer service please call: (810) 694-0101*
- *For emergencies call 911*

Q. Can I bring more than one dog to this park? A. *No more than two dogs are permitted, per handler, at one time. Professional dog trainers are not permitted to conduct training onsite.*

Q. If the park needs to be temporarily closed, what is the best way to be notified? A. *You must agree to opt-in to receive text alerts and/or bulk emails when filling out your Registration Form. A member profile will be built for you in our online registration system: gbparks.recdesk.com*

Q. Can I share my Pass and PIN number with others? A. *Your Membership and PIN are for your household only and only for the dogs you have listed on your Registration Form.*

Q. In addition to my dog park Membership Pass, what else should I have? A. *Dog owners must have their dog licensed with the County or other municipal jurisdiction to apply for a park pass. Current dog licenses must be displayed when using the park.*

Q. If the park needs to be temporarily closed, what is the best way to be notified? A. *Opt-in on your Registration Form to receive TEXT Alerts to your mobile phone or add it to your profile on: gbparks.recdesk.com*

Q. Am I responsible for cleaning up after my dog? A. *Yes. Bags and a receptacle for waste are located on site.*

Q. What should I bring with me to the park? A. *Please remember to have your dog(s) up-to-date license and current Membership Pass accessible at all times. You may want to have water for your dog.*

Q. Will the dog park be policed or monitored? A. *There will not be a person stationed at the dog park; however police monitor the area periodically.*

Q. When does my dog have to be on a leash at the park? A. *Until you and your dog enter the fenced dog play area; your dog(s) must be leashed.*

Q. Why is there a fee for the dog park and what will the monies be used for? A. *An annual dog park membership will be required for access to the designated off-leash dog play areas. The permitting requirement will help enable Grand Blanc Parks and Recreation to provide and maintain the dog play area for users and their pets.*

Q. If my pet is a service dog, do I need to purchase a dog park Membership Pass in Grand Blanc? A. *The fee for the membership will be waived, however, you will still be required to fill out the appropriate paperwork for an application and carry the Membership Pass when utilizing the dog park.*

Q. Do I need to be a resident of Grand Blanc to obtain a dog park membership? A. *No, anyone can use the dog park once their pet meets the requirements to obtain a pass. A non-resident fee of \$10 will be applied.*
