

LACROSSE PLAYERS PHYSICAL INFORMATION

All Grand Blanc Junior Lacrosse Players are required to have a physical before participating in any practice or game. Each player must submit form/statement signed by a physician indicating that he/she is physically able to compete in a supervised lacrosse program (a “limited contact” sport). This form should include the participant’s name, age, weight, address and phone. These forms will be available at our office if your doctor does not provide one. The following options are available for obtaining a current physical:

Walk-In: Wed & Friday 8:00 am – 7:00 pm or Saturday 8:00 am – 3:00 pm

Refund Policy: There will be a \$7.00 administrative fee charged for all refunds. No refunds will be given after the first game. A refund will not be given unless all equipment is returned in full to the GB Parks and Recreation office. If the minimum numbers of players do not sign up, a full refund will be given.

League Issued Equipment: Each player/parent is responsible for their own equipment and uniform, which will be issued by the GBPR lacrosse league. This includes: a helmet, 2 jerseys and a lax stick if needed. All protective equipment must be worn during games, **NO EXCEPTIONS!** All equipment that is rented must be returned following the final game day. ***Any equipment that is lost before, during or after the season will be charged a replacement fee.*** The following fees apply: \$100.00 helmet; \$45.00 Lax stick; \$40.00 jersey. ****Please remember to double check the practice and game field for equipment and turn in any leftover equipment to the league supervisor and/or coach.**
